### F. Reports

a. President's Report

President Craig Guensler deferred his report to Ryan Robison.

Mr. Robison reviewed the last 31 years of rates for TCSIG. The rate history helps give perspective on how TCSIG has remained strong through the years. There was a significant increase for the CDHP plan this year, but we have known that plan was underfunded for a few years, and a correction was warranted. We were consistent on what we did and will continue to strive to be better at managing the pool. The decisions the board has made has righted the ship to balance the pool and things should start leveling out in the next few years so rate increases will stabilize. Mr. Robison has also been gathering information on the rates of TCSIG's competition and after comparing the rates TCSIG is still very competitive.

Dawn Goodman reviewed Plan Amendment #5 which shows the two new plans that TCSIG has added, PPO Low and CDHP Low. This also included adding the medical benefits schedules and prescription coverage information for both new plans. She then gave a brief overview of Resolution #2025-002 which would need to be signed to add this to the Plan Document.

- b. Delta Dental: Ryan Neese
  - i. Annual Report

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Ryan Neese reviewed Delta Dental's annual report. TCSIG continues to do well with a 0.0% increase in paid claims per member per month and 91% of paid claims were with a PPO or Premier dentist. There have also been additional savings from provider discounts. Mr. Neese noted that Delta Dental continues to have the largest network nationally, statewide, and in Sutter County. Overall, the dental industry has been seeing a shift with providers due to economic pressures and providers retiring. To help, Delta Dental has been working with junior colleges by providing grants for people joining the dental field. Delta Dental is also working closely with providers to try to keep them in-network and is reviewing a potential increase for providers. Delta also provides member support through outreach. If a member's email is on file Delta will notify the member if their provider is leaving the network or if they have seen an outof-network provider. Delta Dental strives to be innovative in the dental industry so they are using Epic which is an electronic health records system so they can help with more holistic whole-body health. They also promote heart health through Healthy Smiles, Healthy Hearts and they have started a Dental Clinic partnership in Oakland, CA that explores new technological and treatment advances in dentistry.

#### c. Ameritas

i. Open Enrollment

Marisa Garramore spoke about Ameritas being an option for Open Enrollment. Ameritas was added as a new dental network option effective January 01, 2025. TCSIG had a special dental open enrollment period for this in fall 2024 and some members switched. Now the regular Open Enrollment period has started, and she anticipates more members will switch to Ameritas. To help with Open Enrollment Ameritas has provided TCSIG with flyers, coverage books, and a PowerPoint presentation. They are also sending prizes for the benefit fairs that TCSIG attends. Ameritas has been updating incentive levels for those that move from Delta Dental and have provided financial reports to TCSIG.

#### d. VSP: Jessica Wilson

i. Annual Report

Jessica Wilson provided an overview of 2024. Utilization remains steady and claims are tracking the same. There are more frequent visits but there are lower claim costs. Even though there are more visits we want to encourage more members to get their annual eye exam. TCSIG members are buying more glasses than contacts and the increase in frame allowance to \$180 has been good because members are tending to buy more expensive frames. For lens enhancements members are getting UV lens and nonstandard progressive lens. 96% of utilization is with an in-network provider which is better than the standard book of business.

Marisa Garramore reviewed the start of Open Enrollment. This year TCSIG Admin has been very busy visiting districts for benefit fairs and open enrollment meetings. Some are in person and others are via Zoom. With the rate changes and new plans this year members have many questions. These events have been going very well and TCSIG and the TCSIG Wellness Center has been able to answer many questions for members. Ms. Garramore also stated we are working on a new enrollment video with the help of Shea Smith from the Wellness Center. It should be completed soon, and we will send it out to our districts. Ryan Robison has also visited districts to discuss the rate changes and the plans.

Ms. Garramore then reviewed Resolution #2025-005 which congratulated Webb Construction on their 50-year anniversary. TCSIG has worked with Webb Construction for several projects at 400 Plumas Blvd. Webb Construction has invited TCSIG to their anniversary party, and TCSIG wanted to honor them for all their hard work and on their anniversary.
